 - Please turn in with high school transcript and enrollment of your college.
 - Application should be typed or neatly handwritten.
 - Two letters of recommendation (not from relatives, and not more than one from a school representative) depicting the character of the applicant- typed is acceptable.
 - All applications will be held in strict confidence and reviewed by the selection committee.
