PHILIP H. KENNEDY was born in Chicago, Illinois, on August 1, 1928. He received his B.S. degree from the University of Chicago in 1950, his M.A. in 1951, and his Ph.D. in 1953. He served in the U.S. Army from 1950 to 1952. He was a member of the Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society and the Phi Beta Kappa Society. He was married to [Name] and they had two children.

Dr. Kennedy was an assistant professor of Political Science at the University of Chicago from 1953 to 1956. He then served as a research fellow at the Center for International Studies from 1956 to 1958. He was an assistant professor at the University of California, Berkeley, from 1958 to 1961. He returned to the University of Chicago as an associate professor in 1961 and as a full professor in 1964. He was the director of the Center for International Studies from 1964 to 1971.

Dr. Kennedy's research interests were in international relations, particularly in the area of the Cold War. He was a member of the American Political Science Association and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He was also a member of the National Academy of Sciences. He was the author of several books and articles, including "The Cold War and the American Mind" and "The Cold War and the American Political System".


Dr. Kennedy was a member of the Board of Directors of the American Political Science Association from 1968 to 1971. He was also a member of the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences from 1971 to 1974. He was the president of the American Political Science Association in 1974. He was also the president of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 1974.
