To: City of La Vernia Water Customers

The City of La Vernia water system PWS ID 2470004 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

2nd/3rd/4th 2016 Quarter & 1st Quarter of 2017

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

These violations were a result of the Public Works Director's failure to meet all clerical reporting requirement as stipulated. Personnel changes have taken place and we have proactively implemented measures to insure the City of La Vernia will meet all TCEQ reporting requirements now and in the future. Our Citizen's Health, Safety and Welfare is the single most fundamental job of City employees and your Elected Officials, and at no time were there deficiencies in your water quality!

****Please note that the testing was performed during these quarters and were in compliance with TCEQ regulations but the violations were for failure to report the results to TCEQ.**
