Mayor Gregory gave the invocation, all in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge.

#### 5. Presentation

- A. Presentation from Mayor Gregory regarding the donation of a podium from Joe & Cynthia Farmer, Realty Place.
- B. Presentation of FY 2015 Audit.

Phil Vaugh, with Armstrong Vaughn & Associates, presented the Annual Financial Report to the Council. Stated that this year going forward, due to new software, the city will be in good shape. There is still a surplus in the debt service that can be used on capital lease project as done in the past.

C. Presentation of Public Safety Award for National Night Out.

Sgt. Danny Pitts briefed the Council on the Award for National Night out in which they received 4<sup>th</sup> place. He stated they could not have done it without the help from Jason Scheel and his crew who gathered chairs ice and the necessities. Mr. Ronnie Rye and his crew with EMS and Air Life. We had multiple donations and crews listed below: Whataburger

Sqt. Pitts stated they had fire trucks police cars and it turned out amazing.

We got fourth in the nation and should have been number one. One of the requirements is to have a video. Our local school district, La Vernia ISD, came and videoed but the video was never received. Chief Ritchey stated to the Mayor, "On behalf of our group we would like to recognize you with the 2015 plaque for National Night Out.

Mayor Gregory stated "Our volunteers and police department police and EMS are not only big in their professionalism but there big in their heart. Everybody has one common goal in mind and that is the health and welfare of our citizens. Mayor also stated, "Danny great job this year!" This was a collective community effort and the event was outstanding. We had a record attendance this year.

Sgt. Danny Pitts states tonight will start the planning committee for this upcoming 2016 National Night Out.

#### 6. Discussion/Action

Mayor Gregory stated that there were some changes to the 5-year street plan due to the other capital projects. This is a different process that has been done in the past and puts more of the professional oversite on the engineer. Engineering cost is part of the amount that was budgeted for.

**MOTION:** Councilwoman Moczygemba made the motion to approve the Engineering cost for street improvements, Councilman Doege seconds. **Motion passed: 5-0** 

D. Discuss and consider approving an appointment of a member for the LVMDD Board, Cynthia Farmer.

**MOTION:** Councilwoman Moczygemba made the motion to approve appointing Cynthia Farmer to the LVMDD Board, seconded by Councilman Cormier. **Motion passes: 5-0** 

E. Discuss and consider appointment of Mayor Pro Temp.

**MOTION:** Councilman Cormier made the motion to consider Councilman Schott as Mayor Pro-Tem, seconded by Councilwoman Moczygemba. **Motion passed: 5-0** 

F. Discuss and consider appointing a City Council member to Marie Gerlich's position.

Mayor Gregory noted that Marie Gerlich served our city with such class and dignity. Mayor Gregory stated "I looked around for someone who spent her life in the community. I wanted to find someone with that same scenario. Rhonda and her family have lived and served in the city for many years and with that being said I thought she would be the perfect fit to our Council."

**MOTION:** Councilman Schott made the motion to appoint Rhonda Watson in Marie Gerlich's position, seconded by Councilwoman Moczygemba. **Motion passed: 4-0** 

G. Discuss and consider amending a lease with the La Vernia Historical Association to include Open Carry.

**MOTION:** Councilman Schott approves amending the lease with the La Vernia Historical Association to include open carry, seconded by Council Cormier. **Motion passed: 5-0** 

#### 7. Resolutions

A. Discuss and consider a resolution adopting the City's Investment Policy.

City Administrator advised the investment policy dictates where we can invest city funds.

Nothing has been changed from last year.

**MOTION:** Councilwoman Moczygemba made the motion to accept a resolution adopting the City's Investment Policy, seconded by Councilman Cormier. **Motion passed: 5-0** 

B. Discuss and consider a resolution for Police Grant.

Chief Bruce Ritchey briefed that Alamo Area Council of Government (AACOG) offers a grant that can be used to update or replace current equipment for the police department. This would be used to replace outdated radios and purchase watch guard (WatchGuard is an in-car digital video system typically housed in a compact, overhead console mounted between the visors of most standard law enforcement vehicles.) for the police vehicles. The grant is for \$49,000.00. Sgt. Danny Pitts attended the mandatory training session and now sits on the advisory board. Notification of funding approval will be made mid June-July time frame.

**MOTION:** Councilman Schott made the motion to accept a resolution for Police Grant, seconded by Councilwoman Moczygemba. **Motion passed: 5-0**

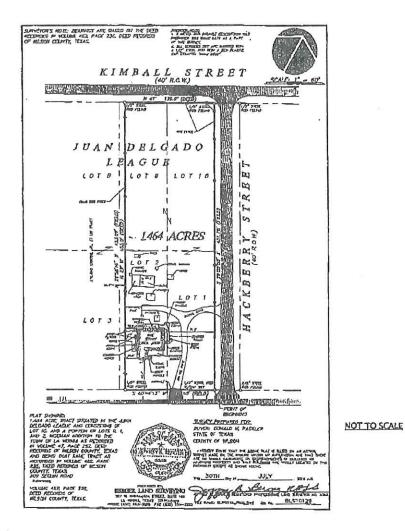

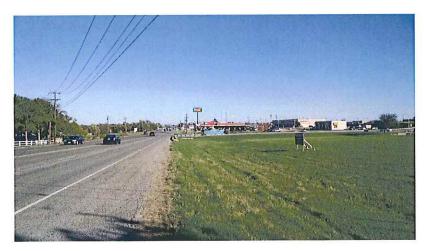

# **REAL PROPERTY DESCRIPTION**

The site is on a 2.907 acre tract of land with frontage on US Highway 87, inside the City Limits of La Vernia, Wilson County, Texas.

The site has one residence located on the property that will be demolished after purchase of the property by the Applicant.





# Zoning

The subject property is zoned C-1 Retail, which allows for retail auto parts sales as a special use. The adjoining properties are zoned C-1 Retail and R-1 Single Family.

O'Reilly Auto Enterprises, LLC, proposes to develop the subject property as an O'Reilly Auto Parts store; being an auto supply store for new and rebuilt parts. #### ORDINANCE NO. 031016-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS, DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES IN THE MAY 7, 2016, GENERAL CITY ELECTION, ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELING THE ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the general city election was called for May 7, 2016, for the purpose of electing members to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Secretary has certified in writing that there is no proposition on the ballot, that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State's recommended first day that an election may be cancelled and all filing deadlines have passed; and

**WHEREAS,** under these circumstances, Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Election Code, authorizes the Board of Aldermen to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 7, 2016 general city election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

Robert W. Gregory, Mayor Eloi Cormier, Councilman Harold Schott, Councilman

**SECTION 2.** The May 7, 2016 general city election is canceled, and the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

**SECTION 3.** It is declared to be the intent of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance is declared invalid by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance since the City Council would have enacted them without the invalid portion.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT FOR THE PURPOSES OF ALLOWING A AUTOMOTIVE RETAILER SPEC RETAIL OR RESTAURANT TENANT SPACE SPECIFICALLY KNOWN AS 14101 US HWY 87 W, CITY OF LA VERNIA, LOT 437D & 438, ZONED C-1 RETAIL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of La Vernia is a General Law Type A City under the statutes of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code authorizes a municipality to adopt zoning regulations designed to accomplish the goals as delineated in Section 211.004 of the Texas Local Government Code and for the purpose of regulating those issues as delineated in Section 211.003 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council of the City of La Vernia, Texas in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Ordinances of the City of La Vernia, have given any and all requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and have held public hearings and afforded a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally and to all persons interested; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission having investigated the manner in which the proposed location and character of such Specific Use will affect the Zoning Ordinance and the comprehensive plan of the City of La Vernia, Texas, make final report and recommendation to the City Council of the City of La Vernia, Texas, recommending that such application be granted; and

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of La Vernia, Texas, finds that the granting and approval of said application for such Specific Use Permit will not adversely affect the character and appropriate use of the area of neighborhood in which it is proposed to be located, will not substantially depreciate the value of adjacent and nearby properties for use in accordance with the regulations of the Zoning District in which they are located; will not be detrimental in keeping with the spirit and intent of said Zoning Ordinance; will not adversely affect traffic, public utilities, public health, public safety and the general welfare under the conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS:

# Section 1. Specific Use Permit Granted

That the Specific Use Permit for an automotive retailer specifically known O'Reilly's located at 14101 US Hwy 87 W, City of La Vernia, Lot 437D & 438, Zoned C-1 Retail be adopted.

#### Section 2. Expiration

The Specific Use Permit granted herein shall automatically expire and become null and void if:

A building permit is not issued and construction has not begun within one hundred eighty

(180) days of the granting of the specific use permit; or

### Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, paragraph, or sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this Ordinance, or application thereof, to any person or circumstance is held invalid such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the same and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions despite such invalidity.

#### Section 4. Cumulative

This ordinance is cumulative of all other laws addressing land use regulations and any prohibitions and sanctions that may be imposed under other laws relating to the subjects covered hereunder.

#### Section 5. Effective Date

#### ORDINANCE NO. 031016-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY AND AMENDING THE CITY'S OFFICIAL ZONING MAP TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF ZONING DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 309 SEGUIN RD, LOT 168 & 169 (LOT 1, BLK 19), LA VERNIA, TEXAS FROM ITS PRESENT CLASSIFICATION OF RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY AGRICULTURE (R-A) TO RETAIL DISTRICT (C-1) AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 211 of the Vernon's Local Government Code empowers a city to enact zoning regulations and provide for their administration, enforcement and amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously deemed it necessary and desirable to adopt zoning regulations to provide for the orderly development of property within the City in order to promote the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the residents of the City, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 38 of the City of La Vernia Code of Ordinances which constitutes the City's zoning regulations requires property to be zoned in accordance with proper zoning district classifications as defined by that chapter; and

WHEREAS, an application has been filed with the City of La Vernia's Planning and Zoning Commission to re-zone the property as more particularly described herein ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is currently zoned as Residential Single Family Agriculture (R-A); and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of La Vernia provided adequate notice to the public and the residents within 200 feet of the property to be rezoned; has held a public hearing in accordance with Chapter 38 of the City's Code and has considered the application for the re-zoning of property specified herein; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of La Vernia has recommended denial of the application for the re-zoning of the designated property to Retail District (C-1) and has confirmed that the re-zoning is uniform and conforms to the plan and design of the City of La Vernia's Zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of La Vernia has also held a public hearing regarding the re-zoning of the described property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of La Vernia believes the re-zoning of the described property will not adversely affect the character of the area of the neighborhood in which it is proposed to locate; will not substantially depreciate the value of adjacent or nearby properties; is within the spirit and intent of the City's Zoning regulations; will comply with applicable standards of the district in which it will be located; and will not adversely affect traffic, public health, public utilities, public safety and the general welfare of the residents of the City of La Vernia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the following property shall be rezoned from Single Family Agriculture (R-A) to Retail District (C-1):

309 Seguin Rd., City of La Vernia, legally described as Lot 168 & 169 (Lot 1, Blk 19), La Vernia, Texas.

**SECTION 2.** The City's Official Zoning Map, shall be amended to reflect the above change in zoning classification for this property as soon as practicable.

**SECTION 3.** The caption of this ordinance shall be published one (1) time in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of La Vernia, Texas.
