1. Call to Order and Declare a Quorum.

5. Discussion and possible action on incentive grants to help beautify La Vernia (Planters.)

The MDD board recommends participants who wish to partake in the planter program submit designs in advance of approval, they also recommend that the city shall reimburse participants in no more than 60 days from date of purchase, The MDD board agrees to fund this program at a maximum of \$5,000.00 per year

MOTION: Given the City MDD Staff will make these changes, Gary Gilbert made a motion to approve the Incentive grant to help beautify La Vernia (Planters,) seconded by Cynthia Farmer. Motion passed: 4-0.

6. Discussion and possible action on reimbursement to General Fund for a portion of the Park Parking Lot.



Rather than reimbursing the general fund for a portion of the parking lot, The MDD board agrees to reimburse the City Sidewalk Project as they feel that is more closely aligned with their mission, thus, they agree to give the city \$200,000 to be used for this purpose

MOTION: Given the City MDD Staff will make these changes, Gary Gilbert made a motion to approve reimbursing the general fund for the Sidewalk Project seconded by Dianell Recker. Motion passed: 4-0.

7. Discussion and possible recommendation of approval to City Council for MDD 2022-23 budget

MOTION: Dianell Recker made a motion to approve the 2022-23 MDD budget seconded by Cynthia Farmer. Motion passed: 4-0.

8. Update on 4th of July

The City Staff presented to the MDD board that they came in underbudget with regard to spending for the 4th of July event. The City Staff recommends to donate the entire proceeds from the silent auction to the Veterans Memorial, the MDD board is favorable of this recommendation.
