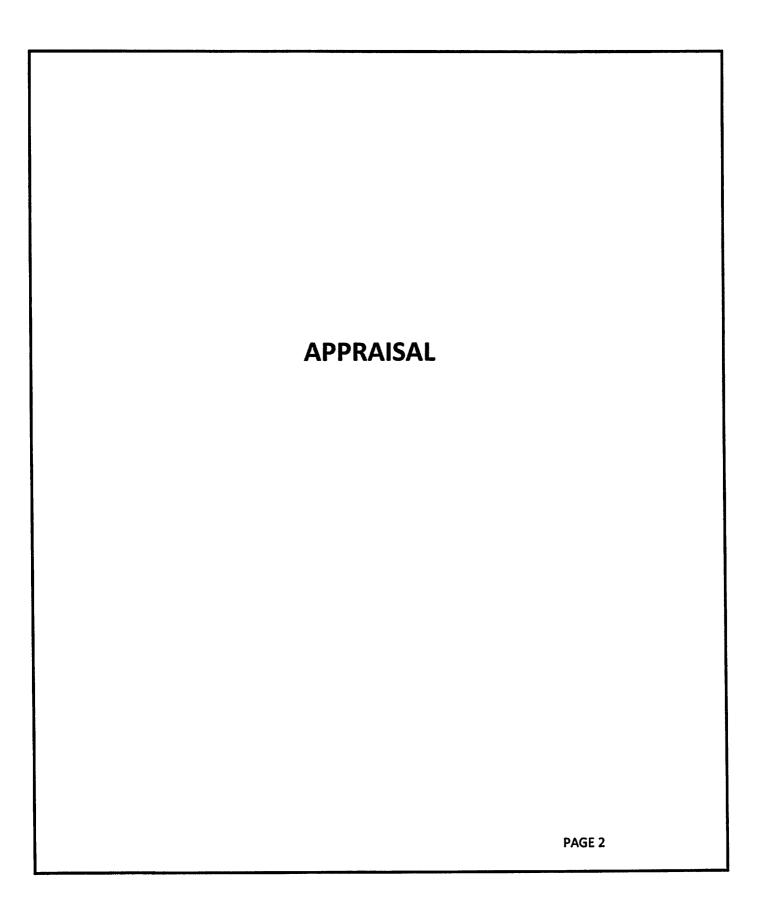

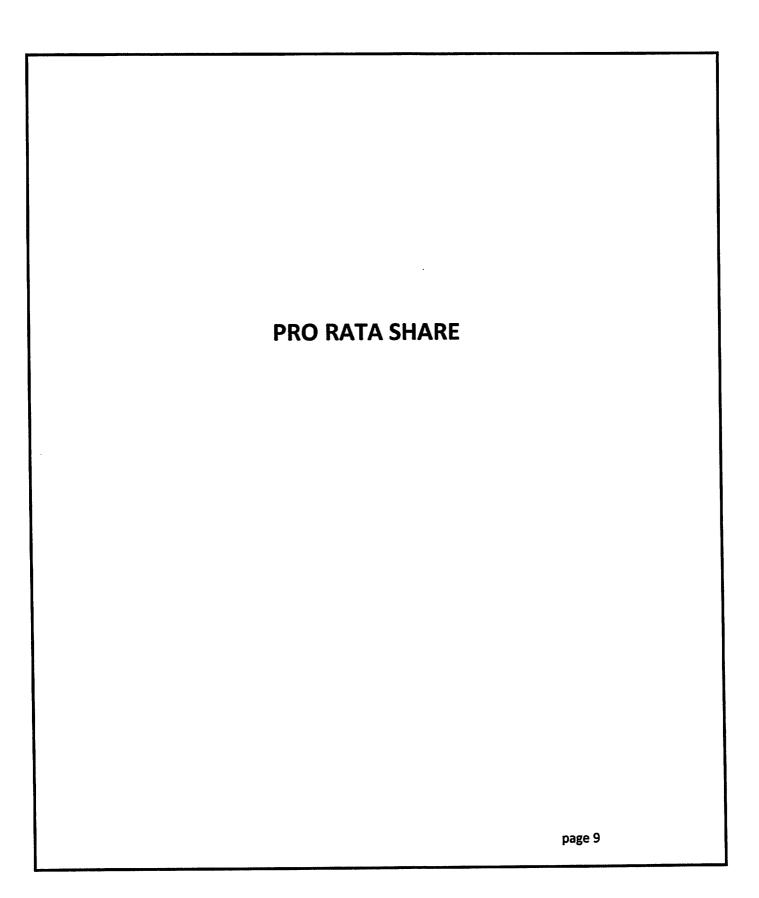

The seal appearing on this document was authorized by Clarence Littlefield, P.E. (Texas Serial #30994) on the date indicated. Alteration of this sealed document without proper notification to the responsible engineer is an offense under the Texas Engineering Practice Act.

During our review of the Water System with the need for more filter capacity, delivery of water to the new Elevated Tank and additional future supply, we have developed several options and considerations.

- Supply Water Wells
- Treatment Filters at Well #6 Site
- Transmission Pipelines from Filter Plant to Booster Station to Elevated Tank
- Pumping VFD pumps at old 50,000 Gallon Elevated Tank
- Elevated Tank Proposed new 500,000 Gallon Elevated Tank near Woodcreek Subdivision

The Water Supply Facilities Map reflects the locations of the City's plants and proposed improvements. Table E-2018 Population Projections was developed to anticipate facility scheduling.

SUPPLY

Well #6 can supply a consistent 300 gpm when not under stress. Well #7 relieved this stress.

Well #7 can supply over 350 gpm. 460 AF per year Callaway agreement is 410,661 gpd average or the well running 19.6 hr/day or 504,000 gallons continuously.

Evergreen Groundwater District desires a production limit of 600 gpd per connection.

The Required Capacity (Table A) provides a comparison of connections and required daily flow.

TCEQ requires a supply minimum of 0.6 gpm per connection. TCEQ also has a planning requirement when capacity reaches 85%.

At a growth rate of 3% developed in Table E, Table B projects the existing 2 wells should be adequate for about 9 years before planning and 12 years before drilling the third well.

TREATMENT

The filter system consists of gravity filters using sand and anthracite coal to remove the iron. The existing plant has 2-7' diameter filters capable of treating 384 gpm at TCEQ limits or 640 connections. The current operation treats about 300 gpm from Well #6 and can treat the 350 gpm from Well #7; however, the 6" transmission line to the Pumping Plant is limited to about 300 gpm.

The proposed expansion will add 2-8' diameter filters at 250 gpm per filter or 500 gpm of additional treatment capacity. All 4 filters (2-7' diameter and 2-8' diameter) would have a combined capacity of 884 gpm and easily treat both Wells #6 and #7 with 650 gpm of combined flow. These filters could treat water for up to about 1,500 connections or through year 2044 at the 3% growth rate in Table E. Adding 2-7' diameter filters in lieu of 2-8' diameter filters would increase capacity to 768 gpm or 1,280 connections.

The Plant as shown on the Master Filter Layout was designed to accommodate the addition of up to 6 filter units for over 1,900 connections using 7' diameter or 2,300 connections using 4 new 8' diameter units. VFD controllers on each transfer pump will allow for controlling the various flows from the wells and system demand. Using the VFD, the transfer pumps could be designed to pump directly to the new Elevated Tank at some future date when the existing booster pumps at the old Elevated Tank are too small, the tank needs repainting or the pumps need to be replaced.

TRANSMISSION MAINS

The existing 10,100 feet of 6" Main from the Filter Plant to the Booster Station as shown

on the Water Supply Facilities Map, is limited to about 300 gpm and matches the individual

well capacities. Therefore, increasing a treatment capacity will also require transmission

capacity. The pipeline would be designed to allow for flows to the booster Station and/or

to pump directly to the proposed new 500,000 gallon Elevated Tank.

With either option, the TCEQ required flow is 0.6 gpm and a probable future transmission

main from the Booster Station to the Elevated Tank in addition to the existing 8" mains in

town.

PUMPING

The pumping system(s) offer several options: (1) continue pumping to the old Elevated Tank

or (2) pump directly to the new Elevated Tank and bypass the existing pump station. The

current system requires two sets of pumps while the direct pumping only one pumping

facility. One pumping is more efficient than two, with less total horsepower and lower

power costs.

However, consideration for continued use of the existing pumps until replacement and life

becomes an issue should be included in the plan. Proper design now with the use of

variable frequency drives would allow for the installation of larger motors running at lower

speeds initially and increasing the speed when the second stage of pumps become non-

functioning.

This means sizing the Filter pumps to pump to the existing Pump Station or to the new Elevated Tank. By using line shaft pumps, a pump bowl can be selected with VFD and large motor to deliver 650 gpm to the pump station (old Elevated Tank) with 50 H.P. and 3 bowls or with 60 H.P. and 4 bowls pump directly to the new Elevated Tank.

Using Table B, the 650 gpm supply is projected to be adequate for beyond 2030. Prior to that time the existing pump station may have exceeded its design life.

This same pump with 3 bowls used for 650 gpm can deliver 1,000 gpm (2-350 gpm wells and 1-300 gpm well) to the Pump Station with a 60 H.P. motor or deliver 1,000 gpm directly to the Elevated Tank with 4 bowls and a 75 H.P. motor. Using Table B this increase would have required a third well and be adequate past 2045.

The use of vertical turbine pumps which normally run at 1,800 rpm results in a life 4 times a 3,500 rpm end suction pump and motor. The VFD also allows the pump to run at slower rates and even longer lifes.

ELEVATED TANK

In selecting the height of the Elevated Tank to serve the entire city, the highest elevation is 620 feet in the Woodcreek Subdivision where Woodcreek Drive intersects CR 344. To provide TCEQ required minimum 35 psi at this point would require the tank overflow to be at elevation 716 feet. With friction losses through the distribution system, the plant pumping pressure would be 110 psi and a static pressure (pumps off) of about 104 psi. this pressure presents several concerns. The older distribution system has been run

between the current 76 psi and about 85 psi. Increasing it to 110 psi would likely result in pipe failures.

The other concern is the pressures at the meters. Some industry standards recommend keeping pressures below 80 psi on the customer side of the meter. With the Elevated Tank located to serve all of Woodcreek would require pressure reducing valves on all services below 550 foot elevation which is all of LaVernia except the western end of Woodcreek and not practical.

The conclusion then is that the existing separate pressure zone to Woodcreek would need to continue. However, the Elevated Tank at the proposed 675 feet could allow for fire flows with pressures above 20 psi.

The pumping to the new Elevated Tank presents minor pressure issues during pumping. The existing Booster Station has been run at various pressures. Currently it is at 76 psi to help reduce the usage. It has been run at about 85 psi. The pumps would need to operate at 93 psi to deliver 480 gpm through the system to the new tank. The following table includes pressures over parts of La Vernia.

Consideration should be given to adding pressure reducing valves to the higher pressure areas (low elevations near Cibolo Creek).

As the City grows and approaches 850 connections, a new transmission main from the Booster Station directly to the Elevated Tank may be required to increase flows and reduce the pumping pressure.

AGREEMENT FOR PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LA VERNIA AND THE LA VERNIA MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

THE STATE OF TEXAS

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

COUNTY OF WILSON

THIS AGREEMENT executed the 19th day of July, 2018, by and between the CITY OF LA VERNIA, a municipal corporation, acting by and through its City Council, situated in Wilson County, Texas (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and the La Vernia Municipal Development District, a municipal development district (hereinafter referred to as "LVMDD") acting by and through its President of the Board is as follows:

WITNESSETH:

I.

The City agrees to provide management, professional, administrative, financial and investment services to the LVMDD according to the terms of this agreement. Direct services the City shall perform for the LVMDD shall include:

- 1. Providing Salary, workers' compensation, health, and retirement expenses for LVMDD employees.
- 2. Preparing all financial and investment reports and keeping all financial books and records required by applicable law.
- 3. Preparing a budget for the forthcoming year for review and approval by the Board and City Council.
- 4. Providing all necessary budgeting, accounting, financial management and investment management through the City's Finance Department.
- 5. Providing accounts payable, payroll, purchasing and other bookkeeping services with oversight and training of such services.
- 6. Providing for a repository of records, office and conference space.
- 7. Providing technology support of hardware, software and phone systems through the City's Information Technology Department.

- 8. Providing for legal services through the City Attorney's office at the rate that those services are provided to the City.
- 9. Providing executive and administrative support, review and oversight by various City departments including but not limited to City Administrator/Executive Director, City Secretary, and appropriate staffing.
- 10. Providing for project management services.

It is understood and agreed that access to City staff resources by the LVMDD is secondary to the needs of the City Council of the City of La Vernia.

П.

Subject to the LVMDD continuing to contract with the City for management services, the LVMDD will pay to the City for its services pursuant to this agreement, in the form of a flat annual fee in the amount of THIRTYNINE THOUSAND AND EIGHTY TWO dollars and 00/100 cents (\$39,082.00). Said amount is to be paid in equal monthly payments of THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SIX dollars and 83/100 cents (\$3,256.83) on the last day of every month.

In addition, the LVMDD will pay to the City the City attorney's hourly fees as charged to the City for all attorney services associated with the LVMDD.

In the event of the termination of this agreement, the LVMDD will be responsible for paying the City only the portion of the cost allocated to periods prior to the effective date of the termination of the agreement.

III.

It is the express purpose of this agreement for the City to provide certain management, professional, administrative and financial services to the LVMDD.

IV.

Subject to early termination as provided in Article V below, this agreement shall be in effect for a period of <u>ONE</u> (1) year commencing <u>August 1, 2018</u> and ending <u>July 31, 2019</u> and said agreement shall be extended for additional one (1) year terms thereafter under the same terms and conditions unless one party gives to the other party written notification at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of the existing term of its desire to terminate the agreement.

V.

1. This contract may be terminated by the City or LVMDD, in whole, or from time to time, in part, upon thirty (30) days' notice from the terminating party to the other party.

Termination shall be effective thirty (30) days after delivery of Notice of Termination specifying to what extent performance or work under the contract shall be terminated thirty (30) days after receipt by the notified party.

- 2. After receipt of a Notice of Termination the City shall:
 - a. Stop work on the date as specified in the thirty (30) day Notice of Termination to the extent possible.
 - b. Place no further orders or subcontracts except as may be necessary for completion of the work not terminated.
 - c. Terminate all orders and subcontracts to the extent that they relate to the performance of work terminated by the Notice of Termination in so far as possible.
 - d. The LVMDD shall pay all expenses incurred through the date of termination.

VII.

This Agreement shall take effect on the day of execution.

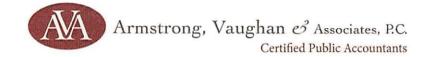

The following represents our understanding of the services we will provide the City of La Vernia.

You have requested that we audit the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the City of La Vernia, as of September 30, 2018, and for the year then ended and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise City of La Vernia's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents. We are pleased to confirm our acceptance and our understanding of this audit engagement by means of this letter. Our audit will be conducted with the objective of our expressing an opinion on each opinion unit.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that management's discussion and analysis, budgetary comparison information, and schedule of funding progress for defined benefit pension plan be presented to supplement the basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by Governmental Accounting Standards Board, who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. As part of our engagement, we will apply certain limited procedures to the required supplementary information (RSI) in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. These limited procedures will consist primarily of inquiries of management regarding their methods of measurement and presentation, and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries. We will not express an opinion or provide any form of assurance on the RSI. The following RSI is required by accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. This RSI will be subjected to certain limited procedures but will not be audited:

- 1. Management's Discussion and Analysis
- 2. Budgetary Comparison Schedule General Fund
- 3. Budgetary Comparison Schedule Municipal Development District
- 4. Schedule of Contributions and Changes Defined Benefit Pension Plan

Supplementary information other than RSI will accompany City of La Vernia's basic financial statements. We will subject the following supplementary information to the auditing procedures applied in our audit of the basic financial statements and perform certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling the supplementary information to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. We intend to provide an opinion on the following supplementary information in relation to the financial statements as a whole:

- 1. Comparative individual fund statements for each major fund
- 2. Combining fund statements for nonmajor funds

Auditor Responsibilities

We will conduct our audit in accordance with U.S. GAAS. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the basic financial statements are free from material misstatement. An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the basic financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the basic financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, misappropriation of assets, or violations of laws, governmental regulations, grant agreements, or contractual agreements.

An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used, and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the basic financial statements. If appropriate, our procedures will therefore include tests of documentary evidence that support the transactions recorded in the accounts, tests of the physical existence of inventories, and direct confirmation of cash, investments, and certain other assets and liabilities by correspondence with creditors and financial institutions. As part of our audit process, we will request written representations from your attorneys, and they may bill you for responding. In making our risk assessments, we consider internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the basic financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. However, we will communicate to you in writing concerning any significant deficiencies or material weaknesses in internal control relevant to the audit of the basic financial statements that we have identified during the audit. Our responsibility as auditors is, of course, limited to the period covered by our audit and does not extend to any other periods.

We cannot provide assurance that unmodified opinions will be expressed. Circumstances may arise in which it is necessary for us to modify our opinions or add emphasis-of-matter or other-matter paragraphs. If our opinions on the basic financial statements are other than unmodified, we will discuss the reasons with you in advance. If, for any reason, we are unable to complete the audit or are unable to form or have not formed opinions, we may decline to express opinions or to issue a report as a result of this engagement.

Management's responsibilities also include designating qualified individuals with the necessary expertise to be responsible and accountable for overseeing all the nonattest services listed below we perform as part of this engagement, as well as evaluating the adequacy and results of those services and accepting responsibility for them. It is our understanding that management has designated Yvonne Griffin to be responsible and accountable for overseeing all services performed as part of this engagement, including the nonattest services we may provide. By your signature below, you acknowledge that management agrees to evaluate the adequacy of, and accept responsibility for, the results of all services performed as part of this engagement. The nonattest services to be performed may include:

- 1. Assistance in preparation of the annual financial report
- 2. Assistance with accrual and government-wide entries
- 3. Other financial assistance as needed, such as depreciation schedules

As part of our audit process, we will request from management, written confirmation concerning representations made to us in connection with the audit.

Reporting

We will issue a written report upon completion of our audit of City of La Vernia's basic financial statements. Our report will be addressed to the governing body of City of La Vernia. We cannot provide assurance that unmodified opinions will be expressed. Circumstances may arise in which it is necessary for us to modify our opinions, add an emphasis-of-matter or other-matter paragraph(s), or withdraw from the engagement.

Other

We understand that your employees will prepare all confirmations we request and will locate any documents or invoices selected by us for testing.

If you intend to publish or otherwise reproduce the financial statements and make reference to our firm, you agree to provide us with printers' proofs or masters for our review and approval before printing. You also agree to provide us with a copy of the final reproduced material for our approval before it is distributed.

Provisions of Engagement Administration, Timing and Fees

During the course of the engagement, we may communicate with you or your personnel via fax or e-mail, and you should be aware that communication in those mediums contains a risk of misdirected or intercepted communications.

We anticipate conducting year end audit procedures in December and issuing a draft report for management's review in early January.

Phil Vaughan is the engagement partner and is responsible for supervising the engagement and signing the report or authorizing another individual to sign it.

Our fee for these services will be our standard hourly rates plus out-of-pocket costs except that we agree that our gross fee, including expenses, will not exceed \$18,600. Our standard hourly rates vary according to the degree of responsibility involved and the experience level of the personnel assigned to your audit. ORDINANCE 062818-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 020912-02 ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TRAFFIC ZONES, INCLUDING SPEED ZONES; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR TH VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING, SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORIDNANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of La Vernia of the City Council has investigated and determined that it would be advantageous and beneficial to the citizens of the City to amend Ordinance No. 020912-02 as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNIA, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED LIMIT IN THE SILVERADO HILLS SUBDIVISION

The maximum, reasonable and prudent speed limits in The Silverado Hills Subdivision should be reduced to following prima facie maximum speed limit hereinafter indicated for motor vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe. Such maximum speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for motor vehicles traveling upon Jessica Street within the Silverado Hills subdivision, and no motor vehicle shall be operated along or upon such portions of the named streets within the corporate limits of the City in excess of the speeds set forth as follows:

1) Twenty (20) miles per hour.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SPEED ZONE SIGNS

A sign(s) indicating the speed of twenty (20) miles per hour shall be installed on Jessica Street within the Silverado Hills Subdivision.

SECTION 3. RELATION TO OTHER ORDINANCES

This ordinance shall not be construed to require or allow any act which is prohibited by any other ordinance. This ordinance is specifically subordinate to any ordinance or regulations of the City of La Vernia pertaining to building and construction safety or to pedestrian and traffic safety.

SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The repeal or amendment of any ordinance or part of ordinances effectuated by the enactment of this ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue or as affecting any rights of the City of La Vernia under any section or provisions of any ordinances in effect at the time of passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this ordinance shall be cumulative of all ordinances not repealed by this ordinance and ordinances governing or regulating the same subject matter as that covered

herein. This ordinance shall not be construed to require or allow any act which is prohibited by any other ordinance.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and section of this ordinance be severable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance and the remainder of this ordinance shall be enforced as written.

SECTION 7. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective and shall be in full force upon adoption and publication.

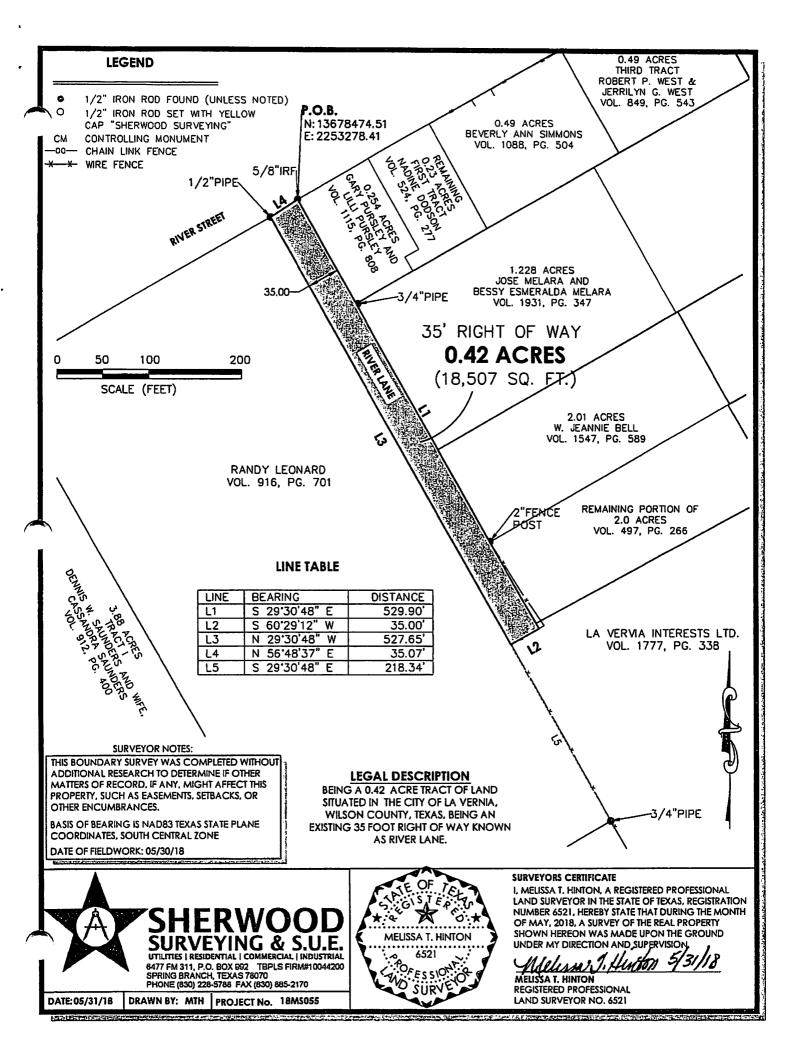

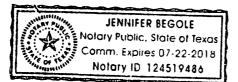
