Guadalupe County issued this Press Release today and realizing many La Vernia and Wilson County Residents travel to Seguin to shop, take note of the dates and times listed where a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 had visited. See dates and times taken from Guadalupe County Press Release 04/06/2020

It is possible that individuals who visited the following locations at the dates and times listed may have been exposed:

- April 1<sup>st</sup> 8:30 AM to 9:00 AM | Walgreens Pharmacy 1357 E Court St Seguin, TX 78155
- April 5<sup>th</sup> 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM | Walmart 550 S, N Hwy 123 Bypass Seguin, TX 78155

The risk of contracting the virus from these exposures is low, and isolation is not required for anyone that does not have symptoms. If you believe you have been exposed, monitor yourself carefully for symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath for 14 days after the exposure. If you experience any of these symptoms and do not need urgent medical attention, isolate at home, and contact your healthcare provider.
