
DISTRICT VISION:

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



DEMOGRAPHICS





LA VERNIA PRIMARY

La Vernia Primary campus serves grades PreK through Second Grade. There are 837 students enrolled, with enrollment continuing to grow daily.



LA VERNIA INTERMEDIATE

La Vernia Intermediate has an enrollment of 824 students, with enrollment continuing to grow, and serves students in Third grade through Fifth grade.

LA VERNIA JUNIOR HIGH

La Vernia Junior High School serves students in Sixth grade through Eighth grade. The current enrollment is 821 students with enrollment continuing to grow.



LA VERNIA HIGH SCHOOL

La Vernia High School has a current enrollment of 971 students and serves students Ninth grade through Twelfth grade.




District Priorities

Safety is the top priority at La Vernia ISD!

In La Vernia, the safety of your student and our staff is our utmost priority. We consistently review and revise our safety plans and procedures to enhance safety and security. Keeping our schools safe requires continuous work and communication with our students, staff, and community involvement.
